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Home visit and walk in policy

Hammond Health does not accept walk in appointments. All patients are required to be registered with the practice prior to making appointments. Appointments can be made by calling the practice or online with hot docs. We hold some book on day appointments, for urgent matters and these can be made by calling the practice at 9am.

Home visits are at the discretion of the individual treating doctor and will usually only be made in circumstances surrounding palliative care or nursing homes.
